*Description of positions*

Math Corps tutors impact hundreds of kids’ lives each year. They work with students to help them achieve math proficiency benchmarks critical for lifelong success. All while building valuable professional experience.

Launch your career while making a difference as a Minnesota Math Enrichment Tutor! This AmeriCorps program plans to place and train over 100 tutors in elementary, middle and junior high schools across the state. As one of these tutors, you’ll use research-based instructional methods during the school day to help students become algebra ready by eighth grade.

During your eleven-month service, you’ll receive extensive training, support and general professional development opportunities. In addition, you’ll receive a modest living stipend, an education award of up to \$5,550 and other benefits if eligible.

All Math Enrichment Tutors will be trained to provide proven, data-driven instruction to children struggling with math. Math Enrichment Tutors work with pairs of fourth through eighth graders in a school. They follow a curriculum and conduct progress monitoring to ensure their students are proficient in algebra by eighth grade. They are placed in elementary, middle or junior high schools and commit to daytime hours.

*Qualifications*

- Strong interest in education, specifically helping youth develop math skills
- Experience working with children, preferably with elementary or middle school ages or as math tutor
- Dedication to community service
- Computer skills, including the ability to navigate and use online database systems and e-mail
- Ability to demonstrate 10<sup>th</sup> grade math skills
- Speak, read, and write English
- Responsible, organized, flexible, motivated, professional
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Ability to make a commitment to complete 11 months of service (August ’12 – June 30, 2013)
- High school diploma or GED and must be at least 18-years-old U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident alien
- *Preferred:* College coursework, college degree, or equivalent work experience
